



Lollipop Bamboo

This two sized bamboo shaped nappy offers excellent absorbency (the most absorbent nappy we've found!) & a slim fit. While bamboo fibres are more absorbent than cotton, they do take longer to dry. To help speed drying without losing absorbency, the nappy has a microfibre core. Cross over tabs at the waist & snug elastic ensure a good fit and excellent containment even on newborns (and even explosive breast-fed pool!).

Bamboo has a scrummy soft silky feel which it retains much better than cotton; it is naturally antibacterial and grows easily without pesticides - an ideal nappy fabric! It is also highly biodegradable and so a great choice for those eco-warriors among you. For more information, see 'Fabrics' info sheet

There is an extra booster with every nappy for more absorbency as baby grows - separate in size 1 to reduce bulk on newborns but attached for ease in size 2.

Fastens with velcro - style Aplix ('hook and loop').

*Size 1: 7-16lbs /around 3kg - 7kg

*Size 2: 16-35lbs / 7kg - 15.5kg



Hunny Highlights

- ✓ Two sizes - ensures good fit & slim fitting. Also reduces wear - useful if to be used on 2nd child
- ✓ Good fit on newborns
- ✓ Environmentally friendly fabric
- ✓ Very absorbent - great for night time use
- ✓ Two-part system - good for containment
- ✓ Great choice for sensitive skin or allergies
- ✓ Anti-bacterial, anti-fungal and anti-static

Nappy Do

- ✓ Pre-wash nappy about 5 times before use to get to full absorbency
- ✓ Re-use wrap if not soiled - simply wipe clean
- ✓ The bamboo nappy must be washed after each use
- ✓ Fold Aplix tabs over to prevent snagging in wash
- ✓ Flush solids down toilet - small residual solids will dissolve in the wash
- ✓ Store in dry nappy bucket until ready to wash
- ✓ Wash at 40°C in non-bio detergent - you only need to use half the recommended amount - plus sanitiser (see [Washing and Drying](#) info sheet)
- ✓ Tumble dry on a cool setting or air dry

Hunny Heads-up

- ! Longer drying time than the Lollipop Softee or Micro (realistically 24 hours if air drying, but quicker if in airing cupboard/on radiator)
- ! If not tumble drying, consider a fleece liner to keep nappy soft against baby's skin
- ! Needs a waterproof outer wrap
- ! If in hard water area, the nappy may go hard over time

Nappy Don't

- ! Do not to use nappy creams/ointments with these nappies unless using a paper liner to protect nappy (see [Nappy Rash](#) info sheet)
- ! Do not tumble on high heat - bamboo is a delicate fabric and this will damage it over time - to keep soft just pop it in dryer for 10 minutes when nearly dry

Hunny Hints

- ✓ Using a fleece liner with the nappy helps to wick moisture away from skin
- ✓ If nappies become hard, give them a good shake to soften
